8.2.1	The institution was advised to consider obtaining consent from proposers and seconders of Engineering Organizations or Units being registered with the Engineering Registration Board (EngRB).
8.2.2	With regards to fundraising for the Northern Region bus, the meeting was informed that a committee was constituted headed by the Regional Vice Chairperson, Eng. Chilala Bowa and that fundraising activities were still ongoing.
8.2.3	A concern was raised on the period of time that the fundraising of the bus was taking, how much had been raised? It was clarified that after a review by the Committee, it was proposed that other activities that are income generating be considered instead.
8.2.4	It was discussed that the Institution consider engaging the industry so as to come up with a workable mentorship programme.
8.2.5	It was discussed that all Branch Chairpersons start submitting planned activities with budgets.
8.2.6	With regards to the constitutional review commission development, the meeting was informed that this was implemented countrywide and the revised constitution shared with members.
8.2.7	With regards to the development and implementation of a new Database Management Information System (DMIS) at Secretariat, the meeting was informed that that was successfully done and was currently in use - physical applications were no longer being accepted. The meeting was also informed that a Quality Management System (QMS) had been implemented at Secretariat.
8.2.8	With regards to the development of a Service Charter, the meeting was informed that this was successfully done and launched in 2021 at Secretariat.
8.2.9	With regards to completion of the Institution's Head Quarter building, the meeting was informed that this was done and the building was occupied by Secretariat in November of 2021. It was clarified also that the building levy was currently only applicable to new members.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Eng. Musonda Chansa - Chairperson Northern Region
Saturday 18th March 2023

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Northern Regional Executive Committee was ushered into office on the 19th of March, 2022 as mandated by the EIZ Constitution. The region comprises of five (5) provinces namely; Copperbelt, Luapula, Northern, Muchinga and North-Western.

The report covers the period between 19th March 2022 and 18th March 2023. The report highlights the activities that have been implemented during the period under review in line with the strategic objectives of the region and the Institution's strategic plan of 2018 - 2023.

I would like to thank my Regional Executive Committee for their dedicated efforts and huge contribution since we were elected into office in March 2022. The support from the members in the region has also been overwhelming and cannot be taken for granted.

Allow me to share with you the activities undertaken by the Northern Region Executive Committee through our Branches in the year under review.

2.0 2022 ACHIEVEMENTS

During the period under review the Committee achieved the following;

- 2.1 Registered a total of 3667 members in the Northern Region.
- 2.2 The region saw the formation of the Northern Region Technical Committee, which is responsible for reviewing ERB applications in the North. This has led to increased efficiency in issuing ERB cards to our members. The previous processing time, which was 30 days, has since been reduced to 14 days.
- 2.3 The region conducted technical tours in Kalumbila and at Mopani Copper Mines.
- 2.4 The region also saw the successful completion of the mentorship programme.
- 2.5 The region also participated in African Engineering week by holding a motivational talk for female engineers at the Mine Club in November, 2022.
- 2.6 Successfully completed the first mentorship programme
- 2.7 The region managed to successfully source for internships for 32 students collectively at Kansanshi, Kalumbila, Mulonga Water and Nkana Water Sanitation and Sewerage Companies.
- 2.8 The region held CPD fora alongside branch elections in Kalumbila, Mufulira, Solwezi, Ndola, Luanshya branches.
- 2.9 Successfully hosted the regional career talk for 12 Schools at Levy Mwanawasa Stadium on the 28th of February, 2023. This was spearheaded by Eng. Sydney Matamwandi, Eng. Misozi Masaninga and Eng. Joe Malisawa.
- 2.10 Held sensitization workshops on how to navigate the DMIS in all the branches

- 2.11 Participated in the regional JETS fair through Branches
- 2.12 Conducted career talks in all the 12 branches in the region
- 2.13 Participated in the World Engineering Day on 4th March, 2023.
- 2.14 Participated in Women's Day on the 8th March, 2023. The region donated various foodstuff and toiletries to Mama-Waluse Orphanage in Chimwemwe, Kitwe.
- 2.15 The Northern region successfully held a ground-breaking ceremony of the Kitwe office graced by the EIZ President, Eng. Abel Ngandu. The Secretariat has since relocated to a temporary location at Wolle Park and demolition of the old building completed.

3.0 FOCUS FOR 2023

- 3.1To continue engaging technicians, technologists and all student members to increase their sense of belonging to the institution.
- 3.2To compel the industry to take up more engineering students on industrial attachment. Alternatively, EIZ was to give an incentive to such engineering organisations such as a 10 percent discount on corporate subscription
- 3.3To engage HEA, CBU and UNZA to intensify stakeholder engagement in reviewing the Zambian university curriculum to suit the needs of industry. This would be done by partnering to organize such workshops, spearheaded by the EIZ sections.
- 3.4To have a technical team visit the dilapidated cafeteria at Solwezi Trades and later come up with a rehabilitation programme by soliciting for funds from various stakeholders.
- 3.5To do an infrastructure report for the Northern Region
- 3.6To engage the various councils on the role of EIZ in CDF projects and have a planned schedule of workshops in each town to encourage entrepreneurial skills among engineers.
