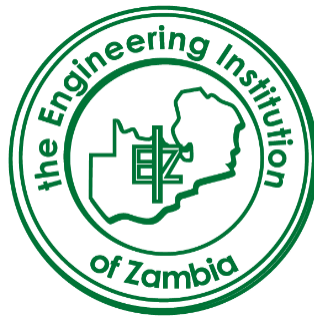

9.2 Matters arising - Action Taken Report

Item	Discussion/Resolution
9.2.1	<p>With regards to engagement of government with on internship programmes, the meeting was informed that EXCOM had scheduled to visit the Ministry of Youth, Sports and Arts in order to make it compulsory to take up students.</p> <p>The meeting resolved that Secretariat would engage the Ministry of Technology and Science for the purpose of accessing the Skills Development funds to support students on internship.</p>
9.2.2	<p>With regards to the submission of charge out rates for Engineering Professionals to the government, the meeting was informed that the submission had been made to the Ministry of Housing, Infrastructure and Urban development.</p>
9.2.3	<p>With regards to accessing the Benevolent fund, Secretariat was requested to consider disabled members.</p>
9.2.4	<p>Secretariat was urged to engage Chinese engineering professionals who were key participants in most road projects in the country, and also to engage them on renewable energy.</p> <p>The meeting resolved to ensure that the works done by the Chinese engineers were of good standard and were executed on time.</p>
9.2.5	<p>The meeting resolved to take punitive action against members carrying out shoddy works and requested them to be firm on the matter.</p>

10.0 Regional Chairperson's 2022 Report

10.1 Discussion and adoption of Regional Chairpersons Report

10.1.1	The region successfully opened Nampundwe (Shibuyunji) Branch.
10.1.2	The region registered a total of 2,145 new members on the database including 577 students, translating to 98% achievement against the four year strategic target of 2,500.
10.1.3	Successfully held 34 physical and virtual CPD activities.
10.1.4	Successfully conducted activities during the 2022 African Engineering Week, which included career talks in branches, panel discussions and participated in radio programs on raising awareness about the Institution.
10.1.5	Participated in the World Engineering Day on 4 th March, 2023 which included a March Past, Student Debates and Women in Leadership Workshop in Lusaka
10.1.6	Successfully conducted a Student Chapter Orientation in order to increase student participation and compliance. These schools included UNZA, Evelyn Hone, Chikupi, LIBES, Choma Trades, LBTC, Kabwe Institute of Technology, Chipata Trades, and Mulungushi University.
10.1.7	Participated in the JETS competition held in Lusaka.
10.1.8	Conducted technical tours to Neon (Lusaka) and Kariba North Bank (Siavonga).
10.1.9	The region participated in Women's Day commemoration on the 8 th March, 2023 by donating toiletries to the City of Hope Charity Home in Lusaka.

10.2 The Chairperson's Report was proposed for adoption by Eng. Lusungu Nyirenda and seconded by Eng. Mushany Kapusana.

11.0 Closing Remarks by Regional Chairperson

11.1 The Chairperson thanked all the members for attending the AGM and making sound contributions. He commended secretariat for hosting a successful AGM.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

1. INTRODUCTION

The current Southern Region Executive Committee has been in office for the past 2 years as mandated by the EIZ Act No. 17 of 2010. The Regional activities cover Lusaka, Central, Eastern, Western, and Southern Provinces of the Republic of Zambia. I would like to thank the Executive Committee for their dedicated efforts and the thirteen (13) branch executives for their tireless efforts and contribution since they were elected into office in March 2022.

Let me also take this opportunity to thank each one of you members for the support extended to us and the Engineering Institution of Zambia (EIZ) in general. I am pleased with the show of commitment exhibited by you all in helping us steer the affairs of the Institution to date.

Let me share with you the activities undertaken by the Southern Region through our branches in the year 2023. The report highlights the activities that have been implemented in line with the strategic objectives of the region and the Institution's strategic plan of 2019 - 2023.

Before moving too far into this report however, I must record the passing on of our members and colleagues in the Southern Region during the period under review;

May we please observe a moment of silence in their honour. Their contributions to EIZ and Zambia in general will be greatly missed.

2. SOUTHERN REGION STRUCTURE

The current Southern Region Branch Executives were voted into office in March 2023 and have held office for over One (1) year. My Chairpersons and their branch Executives have continued to work tirelessly to achieve the goals of my Regional Executive and the Institution at large. Therefore, I wish to encourage members to participate and support all branch activities.

3. SOUTHERN REGION BRANCH REPORTS

The Southern Region now has a total of fourteen (14) Branches. With the latest being Nampundwe which will be officially launched in Q1, 2024. The branches submitted

their quarterly reports to the Southern Region Executive. A summary of the resolutions, challenges, achievements and plans are presented in Table 1 below:

4. REGISTRATION STATISTICS

Secretariat carried out compliance and registrations activities in all five provinces of the region, visiting organizations and units, universities, technical colleges and trade schools. These activities included compliance inspections, new membership registration and renewals.

During the year under the review:

- 4.1 Membership and inspectorate units inspected a total number of 2927 Organisations and units.
- 4.2 Registered a total of 2,776 new members on the database.
- 4.3 Registered a total number of 761 new students on our database.
- 4.4 Achieved a compliance rate of 83% for Engineering Professionals and 84% for Engineering Organisations and Units.

In the year under review, secretariat managed to visit all the provincial centres in Lusaka, Central, Eastern, Western, and Southern Provinces of the region.

5. COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

- 5.1 Successfully held four (4) Southern Region Executive Committee Meetings in the year 2023.
- 5.2 Registered a record number of 2776 new members on the database representing a performance of 11.5% achieved for the region against the four-year strategic target of 24,000. (23% against regional four-year strategic target)
- 5.3 Registered 761 new students on the database.
- 5.4 Successfully held 23 physical and virtual Continuous Professional Development Activities, 3 motivational talks, 4 career talks, and 1 school quiz.
- 5.5 Conducted technical tours to Kariba North Bank Power Station (Siavonga), Kafue Gorge Lower Power Station (Chikankata), Lusemfwu Hydro Power Station (Kabwe), and Kazungula Bridge (Kazungula).
- 5.6 Successfully hosted the Young Engineering Professionals Workshop with Prof. Clive Chirwa.
- 5.7 Conducted a non-paid CPD training - Cost Estimation of Engineering Projects.
- 5.8 Facilitated the Coding Workshop at the National Science Centre, Lusaka.
- 5.9 Participated in the National JETS fair at the National Science Centre, Lusaka.
- 5.10 The Energy Auditor's Section successfully carried out an Energy Audit of the Engineering House, Lusaka.
- 5.11 Successfully conducted activities during the 2022 African Engineering Week which included career talks in branches, panel discussion and participated in radio programs on raising awareness about the Engineering Institution of Zambia.
- 5.12 Hosted webinar on Strategic Management.

5.13 Successfully held the Southern Region End of year Networking Gala Dinner.
